Introduction

This is a practical work-related course that prepares pupils for further study and life in the work place. The course explores life-skills such as communication, numeracy and IT and helps develop not only knowledge but also self-discipline and confidence through a focus on the various subjects offered.

Course Content

The course is made up of a Level 1 Certificate in Workskills.

Workskills BTEC requires pupils to gain 13 credits by completing a selection of units including:

- Using a CV & covering letter to apply for a job
- Applying for jobs
- Achieving success at interview
- Managing your own money
- Developing resilience for work



Assessment

The course has a practical basis and is non-examination based. Pupils will be required to compile a portfolio of evidence to demonstrate their achievements. All pupil portfolios are internally assessed and a sample of pupil portfolios and presentations are externally verified by Edexcel.
