Government funding for careers advice and guidance services in schools has been cut both nationally and locally. However, here at Forest we are committed to providing the highest level of support to our students, ensuring that they have all the necessary information to make an informed choice for their Post 16 destination. Support is tailored to the needs of each individual student.

The provision provided at Forest is significantly above most secondary schools across the country. This has resulted in the school being well above the national average on the Gatsby Bench Marks, which is how careers provision is now judged within schools.
