Vacancies for Parent Governors at The Forest School

The Instrument of Government for this school provides for the appointment of **six** Parent Governors who are elected by the parents of pupils registered at the school and who are themselves such parents at the time when they are elected. The term of office provided by the Instrument is four years.

There are currently **two vacancies** at our school for a Parent Governor. If you wish to stand for election as a Parent Governor of the school, please complete the nomination form. Completed nomination forms must be returned to the school office, addressed to the Clerk to the Governors, either in a sealed envelope marked **"Nomination Form"** or scanned and emailed in to: <u>ewright@theforestschool.net</u> by **no later than Monday 11th October 2021**.
