Consists of approximately 130 hours of learning split over 4 different topics:

- Preparing for a safe journey by road
- Recognising safe road use
- Maintaining own and others safety in relation to vehicles
- Rules of the road this is an online exam (Driver Theory Test)

Passing this course entitles you to a reduced driver theory test and a reduction in cost
