#### Why does work experience matter?

#### Work Experience is just:-

- Making cups of tea
- Making photocopies
- Sweeping the floor
- Cleaning the toilets

**WRONG!** 

#### Why do work experience?

- Increase confidence and independence
  - exposure to new people and situations
- Help you decide what your career ambitions may be
  - opportunity to observe & experience the realities of work
- Increase motivation and sense of purpose
  - develop understanding of links between school subjects and the world of work
- Develop Vocational Skills

### Why do work experience?

- Discover and develop personal qualities
  - talents and interests that you may not yet know about yourself!
- Help to make you stand out from your peers
- Gives you the edge when applying for jobs
- Obtain evidence for interviews and Further Education applications
  - great CV material
- Develop skills valued in all workplaces
  - planning, organising, time keeping, interacting with people, following instructions....

#### Rules about Work Experience

- All placements must have a current health & safety risk assessment and liability insurances in place
- Parental contribution of £25 requested (school is subsidising)
- Placements outside West Sussex are more expensive for H &S (around £50 parental contribution)
- Need to arrange own transport think about how you will get there when choosing placement
- Very few prohibited placements & activities we try not to say no
- Not compulsory, strongly recommended

- Beware sole traders: must have Employers Liability Insurance or you CANNOT go unless close family relative

- Job types are ranked category 1, 2 or 3. Ensure you select at least 1 area in category 3.
- First come first served

- Try to be as flexible as you can regarding travel
- Confirmation of placement through tutor packs
